Fee Increase

Increase in nursery fees from 30th March 2020

Nursery fees have recently been reviewed, in line with the 6.4% national minimum wage increase and it has been decided to increase nursery fees from 30th March 2020.

We have tried to keep our fee increases as low as possible; however rising costs such as increased wages costs due to an increase in National living wages, heating, lighting and other general inflationary costs have necessitated the increase. However, our fees continue to be cheaper than most other providers in our local area.
